This year marks the 17th, annual IYK English Speaking Contest and with last year's changes to the contest being so successful, we have decided to make further changes this year. We are looking to bring an even more fun atmosphere to the contest this year and to create a more relaxed environment to bring the best English out of the children as possible.

Like last year, the contest will be divided into 3 levels, one for each grade (Junior, Intermediate and Senior), and as always, consist of 2 categories, the English Speaking and English Listening tests. As the name of the contest suggests, speaking is the main focus, with this years Listening test becoming slightly shorter, but also adding a fun, new, live/action based section. The Speaking test will change significantly this year, becoming more lesson / activity based and in a change to previous year's contests, the children this year DO NOT need to bring any items from home.

The reasons behind the changes to this years tests is to not only make the most out of our 8 Overseas teachers, but to provide a more relaxed, stress free environment, without the pressures of tests and contests the children will face later in their lives and to encourage all of the participants to have fun whilst communicating with others in a foreign language.

There is very little the children can do to prepare, with the questions, topics and challenges involved all being a review for them.
